<p>In Early Years, children embark on a journey of discovery and exploration. As much as possible, the children's own interests are explored and utilized as vehicles to support their development and learning, as well as exploring the seasons, religious and cultural events, and National days. The importance of looking after ourselves, each other, the school and the wider environment is emphasised, to ensure the children have a strong sense of self and themselves in the world and the foundations are set for their next phase of learning.</p>												
Nursery		<p>Use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials, explore collections of materials and talk about similar and/or different properties and changes they notice. Plant seeds and care for growing plants. Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant and an animal and the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things.</p> <p>Explore how things work.</p> <p>Begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.</p> <p>Show interest in different occupations</p> <p>Know that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos.</p>			<p>Take part in simple pretend play, make imaginative and constructive small worlds with construction kits, and small world equipment.</p> <p>Explore and develop ideas and decide which materials to use to express them. Join different materials and explore different textures.</p> <p>Create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent objects.
