Shield Row Ofsted 2018: Early Years Provision

Teaching is lively and energetic. Teachers foster real enthusiasm and curiosity in children through the well-planned curriculum. Every opportunity is taken to foster children's grasp of basic skills in reading, writing and number.

Helpful learning resources are easily accessible for children both indoors and in the outdoor areas, which are skilfully utilised by teachers.

Children play happily together and quickly develop mature social skills because of the well-organised and structured day. They learn to concentrate and to apply themselves productively to tasks.

At Shield Row Primary School, we offer the following options:

Option 1 – Universal 15 hours

- Children attend Nursery 8:45am – 11:45am Monday to Friday during term time.
- If children wish to have their lunch at school there are two options:
 - Your child can bring a healthy packed lunch and there is a cost of £2.00 per day for the later collection time of 12:30pm.
 - If you would like a school lunch providing, the total cost for food provision and care is £4.15 per day.

Option 2 – 30 hours entitlement

- Children attend Nursery 8:45am – 3:30pm Monday to Friday during term time.
- Parents must supply a healthy packed lunch or pay £2.15 per day for a school lunch.
- There is a cost of £2 per day for lunchtime supervision

Option 3 – Universal 15 hours + 15 paid hours

- Children receive their 15 hours of free Nursery education every morning, and parents pay for an additional session on the afternoon.
- The cost is £73 per week and payments must be made at the beginning of each week.
- Parents must supply a healthy packed lunch or pay £2:15 per day for a school lunch.

In order to confirm a 30 hour place for your child, you are required to apply for the additional 15 hours of Nursery education using the application form found at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. Once the application has been successful, you will be given an 11 digit 'eligibility code' for your child. We must receive this eligibility code alongside both parents National Insurance numbers. We can only secure a place for your child if we have received this number.
